31 DAY PASS

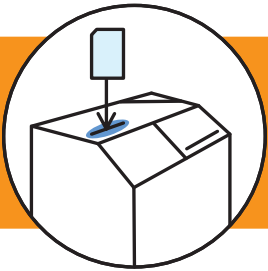
FLEXIBLE. CONVENIENT. SAME LOW PRICE.

The Metro's new 31-Day Pass lets **you** decide when your monthly rides begin. Start riding the day you buy it or tuck it away for another day. From day 1 to 31, the pass is valid. That's unlimited rides until your pass expires.

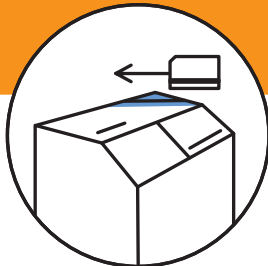
HERE IS HOW THE PASS WORKS.

The first time you use your pass, insert it in the top slot on the farebox. The farebox will imprint the First Use and Expiration dates on the back of the pass. From then on, just swipe your pass through the reader until the pass expires.

The Metro Reduced Farecard or a Medicare card
when purchasing and using their pass on the bus.
Otherwise, customers will be required to purchase a
Full Fare Pass or pay the fare difference.**

THE RIGHT PASS AT THE RIGHT PRICE.

31-Day Passes display the pass type – Reduced Fare, Full Fare and Commuter Express – on the front instead of the price.

- \$25 Reduced Fare Pass. Valid on all Metro routes except commuter express routes. (Persons with disabilities, youths 12 to 18 years of age and seniors 65 and over must show a Metro Reduced Farecard or Medicare card.)
- \$50 Full Fare Pass. Valid on all regular Metro bus routes.
- \$95 Commuter Express Pass. Valid on routes 34X-Shoal Creek/Liberty, 152-Raytown/Lee's Summit and 170-Blue Springs Express.

BUY PASSES ONLINE OR AT METRO PASS OUTLETS.

The flexible, convenient pass is available at public outlets throughout metropolitan Kansas City. Refer to the list on the back or go online at store.kcata.org. **(Reduced Fare ID required to purchase half-fare pass online.)**
