

ACTIONS APPROVED BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING AUGUST 22, 2018

Consent Items:

Approval of Minutes

The Board approved the minutes of the July 25, 2018 Regular Board meeting.

2018 Regional Operating Results through July

The Board received the report.

Heavy Duty Truck

The Board authorize a \$460,468 purchase from Olathe Ford five Ford F450 Crew Cab 4x4 trucks with appropriate accessories and spares.

Board Ratification for Exercise of Third-Party Administrator Option Year 1

The Board ratified the one-year extension option with Thomas McGee, L.C. in an amount not to exceed \$164,608 for the period of November 1, 2018 through October 31, 2019.

Missouri State Operating Grant

The Board approved the resolution authorizing the Chair of the Board to execute an application and agreement with the Missouri Department of Transportation.

KCMO Agreement Amendment on Prospect MAX

The Board authorized Amendment 1 to the Cooperative Agreement between the City of Kansas City, Missouri and KCATA for Prospect MAX.

Design Contract Amendment for Prospect MAX

The Board authorized an amendment to Taliaferro and Browne's contract in the amount \$677,516.

HRIS Implementation Project – Adams-Gabbert Project Manager Contract Extension

The Board approved a \$59,400 increase to the Adams-Gabbert contract for a total adjusted contract of \$208,560. Funding for this project is included in the 2018 operating budget. This project includes local funds only and does not use federal funding.

KCMO Employee Pass Program Annual Agreement

The Board authorized a one-year contract the City of Kansas City, Missouri effective May 1, 2018, for the continuation of the KCMO employee pass program with a required City contribution of \$192,056.



Action Items:

Primary Excess Liability Policy Renewal

The Board approved \$188,032 eleven-month agreement for Primary Excess Liability Insurance, with Princeton Excess and Surplus Lines Ins. Co.

Selection of Tenant for 39 & Troost and Authorize Negotiation of Lease Agreement

The Board authorized the staff to negotiate a long-term agreement with Urban Inner City Services for use of KCATA's facility at 3827 Troost Avenue in Kansas City, Missouri, subject to future Board approval of such an agreement.
