#### **REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATIONS**

- 1. Under Section 2.3 Scope of Work, Part B, Item B, it states that any officer assigned to this post must have a minimum of 5 years of security and/or law enforcement experience. Would military experience fulfill this requirement, as well?
- A. Yes, if of a comparable nature. Combat arms, military police, especially. Purely administrative work while in the military might not satisfy. DD214 will have the relevant information from which to decide.
- 2. Pricing and more specifically wages. We are confirming that KCATA does not want to see wages for the security officers? The RFP does not indicate a minimum wage that has to be paid to the officers. This is very important as it relates to the quality of the officers and the mark-up each security company adds to the price.
- A. No, this is not required. However, please note that KCATA will have a higher standard of weight when selecting candidates. The requirement is for class A Patrol Agent.
- 3. Please confirm there will be no walk-through date to visit the property and get a better understanding of officer duties?
- A. The positions in question to a large degree do not yet exist. They will be campus security and facility security, but the ability to deal with hostile situations and problem persons is a requirement. The facility will be open to the public in the city center 18-20 hours a day. Dealing with rider safety and the exclusion of no rider transient person will be a daily function. Personnel must be well trained in subject control, arrest and detention and handcuffing. The supervisor position will have authority equivalent to or ATA road supervisors.

KCATA has scheduled a walk-through for Monday, July 15, 2019 at 1:00 P.M. Interested vendors will meet at the KCATA Central Complex located at 1350 E. 17<sup>th</sup> Street, Kansas City,

MO 64108. KCATA will then transport all attendees to the various locations and construction sites for view. This could take approximately 4 hours to complete. Seating is limited. KCATA respectfully request that companies send no more than 2 people to attend the walk-through.
