GENERAL INFORMATION

The closing date for proposal submissions is extended to **January 28, 2022 by 2:00PM Central Time.**

There is a revised model # for the Axis P3246-LV (not rated for outside) that is changed for the 10 locations, outside, which require the **P3247-LVE**, as the correct model for outdoor rated camera.

Attached is a copy of attendees for the on-site campus walk through on 1/12/22, see attached Appendix B.

PROPOSAL CLARIFICATIONS

1. Q: Please put out a list of the current working and non-working cameras.

A: See attached Appendix A.

2. Q: Can we install the cameras on the beams along the walkway in the Bus Barn?

A: This acceptable if the cameras do not create an obstacle or hazard for buses or people. The awarded/selected vendor will have to submit shop drawings.

3. Q: Do we need to Document the cabling as installed? If so what level ? Can you give an example?

A: Please bid the approximate quantities in the solicitation. The awarded/selected vendor will be asked to provide a diagram/map of any new cabling installed. Including type of cable, end point connections (i.e. Camera 3 connected to Building One Server Room, Patch Panel A-10), and patch panel number/information. This should also be labeled on all cables and network jack locations for easy reference and cable tracing.

4. Q: The ongoing maintenance is going to be an on-call break/fix?

A: This should include recommended routine maintenance, software or firmware upgrades as needed, and on-call break/fix support.

5. Q: Fiber, Single mode or Multi mode? What strand count will you want installed?

A: Single mode. Vendors should run a multi-strand fiber bundle for redundancy. A 12-strand fiber bundle is recommended.

6. Q: Can we reuse any fiber current installed?

A: Can reuse fiber provided you perform a thorough end-to-end test to make sure it is in good condition.

7. Q: The RFP makes mention of salient systems. But understanding is that we are to provide an addition for an existing Genetec system, can you clarify?

A: The proposed cameras need to be compatible with our existing Genetec system; however, the salient characteristics are the standards that need to be met if proposing cameras other than the models listed as examples.

PROPOSAL CLARIFICATIONS

1. Q: Who is disposing of the old cameras being removed?

A: Vendor/Contractor

2. Q: Old cabling removal, who is disposing of the old cable?

A: Vendor/Contractor

3. Q: Are vendors supplying the SFP modules?

A: KCATA will supply any required SFP modules. Vendor shall specify the number of Fiber vs. Ethernet connections for each switch location.

4. Q: How often will the Davis-Bacon wage report be required?

A: Every 2 weeks

5. Q: Will you require the quad view for the Q6010-E/Q6075-E, if so, it requires an extra license?

A: Yes (if applicable)

6. Q: Are vendors required to upgrade any penetrations we use on this project for fire protection?

A: Yes, if required by code.

7. Q: There is concern that the time allotted to complete the cabling and conduit work will be sufficient to complete the job. Can a request of 45 days be agreed to?

A: Yes, 45 days for the conduit and cabling work is acceptable

8. Q: What type of Fiber is currently installed in the building?

A: OM3 Multi-mode

9. Q: Will permits be required for installing conduit under the street to bring the parking lot cameras to the guard shack?

A: Yes, if it's a public street.

10. Q: Will the workstations and displays be provided by KCATA?

A: Yes

11. Q: Will vendors need to handle the utility's location for the boring part of this project?

A: Yes

12. Q: Can you please clarify the number of licenses required, 69 total 56 locations?

A: The base bid includes 30 camera locations. The Add Alternate Bid includes an additional 26 camera locations. Actual license requirements should be determined by the vendor according to the number and type of cameras proposed.

13. Q: Can you please clarify the number of workdays. NTP 30 or 45 days to get cabling/wire; NTP 30 days camera installations?

A: See 7 above. Days are calendar days.

14. Q: Are the switches single or dual?

A: Each switch location (Building One and Breen) has two Core Switches (Dell/EMC S5248F-ON) and up to four Access Switches (Dell/EMC N2248px-on).
